Application Criteria and Process

Swindon Music Service (as lead organisation for the Make Music Swindon hub) will identify a pot of money annually and offer Hub delivery partners the opportunity to apply for development grants. Once the grants have been allocated for the year, the application process will close until the following year. The grant is provided to help certain costs, as exemplified below:

(Note: not limited to these examples):

- Continued Professional Development (CPD).
- extending existing musical resources (excluding musical instruments).
- Developing the organisation (such as publicity and marketing).
- Local research programmes, as agreed with SMS.

What does Swindon Music Service expect in return for the grant?

If you are successful with your grant application, on completion we expect you to share your experience with us by telling us what has worked well and why.

Who can apply for the grant?

If you are already a recognised partner of **Make Music Swindon** music education hub, you can simply complete the application form and submit it. Finance

- Local delivery partners with an employee size of **2 10** can submit an application up to a maximum of £300
- Local delivery partners with an employee size of 11 upwards can submit an application up to a maximum of £500

Your application submission must set out clear organisation developmental programmes, professional development or research that aims to support music education in Swindon.

Those successful organisations agree to supply relevant to inform the ACE annual data return.
