Supporting musical activity for schools: turning challenges into opportunities


How will Swindon Music Service continue to support your school during the new lockdown?

We will be providing music hub member schools (KS1&2) with an alternative service in the following form, during term 3 lockdown:


- A weekly email from an experienced SMS tutor to your music coordinator.
- This email will **provide advice on a themed selection of Charanga** (online music) resources which can be used by pupils at home.
- Because SMS has provided your school with a Charanga licence (at no cost) each of your pupils can have the **facility to log-in from home** to access these musical resources.
- The tutor liaising with your music coordinator will be there as a **source of musical support** if there are further question and queries.

As a music hub member school there are other music facets that we think you may find useful over the coming weeks:

- Your school will continue to receive **national musical guidance updates from Music Mark** (free membership of Music Mark is provided as a benefit of your local music hub membership).
- Your school will be able to access a range of music resources via the SMS website, including selections from our **song bank and a range of music CPD materials for teachers**.
