- Make a special piece of artwork to go with this song. You'll need a black piece of paper, some glue, some silver glitter and a silver pen. Write the numbers 1-12 in a circle around the edge of the paper (like a clock), then with the glue connect all the numbers together, going across the page and also from one number to the next to create a web. They can then add more web-like links between the lines already created. Sprinkle on the glitter and you have the spider's 'clock' web. The children can draw a spider on the web and perhaps a fly for it to catch!
- Talk about why spiders spin webs. What do they trap in them and why?
- Talk about how useful spiders are for us.
