SMS tutor work in schools 2021/22

School Orders - Overall, schools have ordered a little more in 2021-22 compared to 2020-21. What is encouraging is that, despite the disruptive year, schools have ordered more than the previous year. Most, if not all, of you will have increased workload, which should offer further stability for you in the coming year.

Individual Tuition - This appears to be a growth area at the moment. If having scheduled all your current work offers from SMS you have some spare capacity, do let us know. We would like to offer opportunities to our existing tutors first before looking for new ones to come on board SMS.

Supporting Music Hub Delivery Partners

Since April 2021, we have provided grant funding to the value of **£44k** to some of our partners in support of delivering the National Plan for Music Education (NPME).

The following grants have been awarded:

- £30k Charanga to provide all primary school hub members with free access to the eLearning platform
- £2k Focus on Sound to provide all secondary school hub members with free access to the eLearning platform
- £4k to JTP Trust (in support of the hub's singing strategy and inclusion)
- £3k to Ultimate Tuition (in support of continuation and inclusion)
- £3k to Holmes Music (in support continuation and inclusion)
- £2k Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra outreach (concert for GCSE students)
- £600 School song downloads
